## Financial Update (Arthur)

We started the year with \$8,137.97 and finished with \$11,787.70 in the bank. However, the final amount is due to a generous \$10,000 donation from a member. We actually ended the year with a **\$6,350.27 loss.** 

The largest expenses were \$10,840.00 for rent and \$7,651 in directors' fees.
